

# Harvard 4th of July Committee

### Approval of Minutes and Old Business

No previous meetings of this group for this year.

## Approval of Agenda

Agenda was presented but not approved. Everyone was in agreement that the meeting was being held to discuss use of space and crowd control

#### Use of Space and Crowd Control

Discussion on use of space and crowd control:

- It was determined that Fruitlands/The Trustees WILL NOT advertise this event nor will offer discounts to Trustees members. They will only have information about the fireworks, billed as a Town of Harvard event, on the website to alleviate the dozens of phone calls Catherine fields as the date approaches.
- It was determined that we will not rent out the space in a formal capacity but will pay Fruitlands \$1/car with a maximum of \$2000 to be paid. This is their nonprofit rate for use of the space.
- New sculptures will be on the property during fireworks. We discussed that keeping said
  artwork safe should be a priority of Fruitlands and that we would try to station a volunteer in
  places that damage may occur to discourage unintended damage to that or any other Fruitlands
  property.
- In conjunction with the above conversation, it was discussed that 4<sup>th</sup> of July needs to offer Fruitlands a copy of the Town of Harvard's insurance certificate and that a contract of sorts should be drawn up.
- Last year the fireworks company arrived too early, causing the museum to shut down early, per
  order of the Harvard Fire Department. We agreed that the firework company shall be contacted
  well before the event to reiterate they cannot come onto the property prior to THREE PM. Also,
  a representative from the fireworks company shall check in with Fruitlands before entering the
  property.

# Open Issues

- Certificate of insurance and contract to be procured after talking to Town Hall
- Anne will talk with fireworks company to assure that they arrive at the correct time
