ON-GOING BUSINESS:

1. Bromfield wall rebuild (EL) HHC discussed the awarding of the bids. Contractor has 30 days to sign the contract.

Monument Committee (DV) There is a \$2000 matching grant for repairing the WWI monument. The committee has not raised that amount yet but is in the process. The brass plaques have been cleaned. The top two pieces are granite then concrete below. Committee is looking at prices for concrete replacement.

CPC (PM) CPC met and voted to spend money on Old Library walkway and monument costs. Dean's Hill was removed from the list as it was withdrawn from conservation request because the owners would not entertain anything under \$900,000.
