#### **Minutes**

### Treasurer's Report

- 1. The available fund balance is about \$176.5K as of 1/2/2018. The Trust is expected to pay \$140K to Emerson Green in Devens as it starts the second-phase project, which includes 25% of affordable housing.
- 2. The major source of the fund comes from Community Preservation Act revenue. Currently it is about \$27K per year. The other source is occasional transactions of Trail Ridge Way condor
- 3. The cross-state goal is to reach 10% of affordable house in town. Harvard now is about 6%. Upon the completion of the second-phase project of Emerson Green, the town will improve by 1%.

#### **Discuss Goals for MAHT**

The members of trust exchanged opinions.

- 1. Barton proposed to refer to deed restriction development in Boston area. Members also discuss the possibility to target senior citizens as the potential market.
- 2. The Trust will collect and analyze the data of previous trades of affordable housing.
- 3. Chair assigned Chiou to figure out the updated definition of affordable housing by the Commonwealth.
